**Priority 3:** Learning analytics support and networks

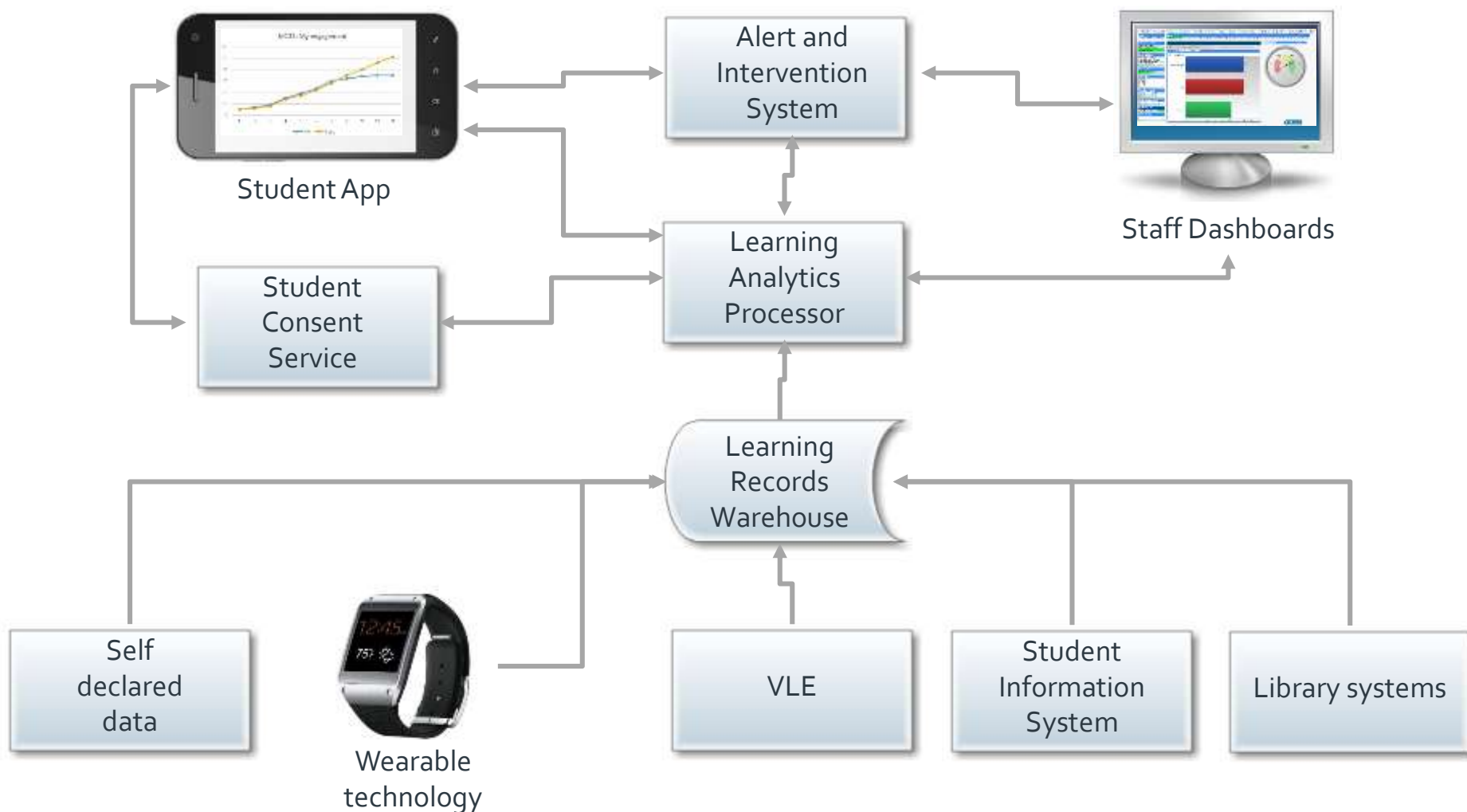


# Basic learning analytics solution

## Updated timetable

<b>May –June 2015</b>	Initial meetings with selected suppliers to initiate contracts and develop products.
<b>June – Sept 2015</b>	Institutions invited to participate in <b>Discovery Stage</b> or <b>Pilots</b>
<b>Year 1</b> <b>Sept 2015 - Aug 2016</b>	Discovery Stage (10-20 institutions) Pilots (10+ institutions) Institutions move from Discovery to Pilot
<b>Year 2</b> <b>Sept 2016 - Aug 2017</b>	Discovery Stage (scaled solution) Institutions move from Discovery to Pilot Institutions continue Pilots, potentially adding other services

# Priority 1: Basic learning analytics solution



# Discovery Phase

Stage 1: Questionnaire to collect readiness information and for institution to express interest. (June/July onwards)

- » Discovery – Select preferred approach for the discovery phase. Open to ~20 institutions
- » Pilot – Select solution preference (Year 1 - 15 proprietary and 15 open).

Stage 2: Provide a scalable discovery phase with an online tool and support via consultants and/or Jisc. Open to all institutions.

Institutions select preference for solution. Open to all.



# Code of Practice

## Next steps

Advisory Group includes representatives from National Union of Students, Edinburgh, Huddersfield, Lancaster and Loughborough Universities, Bucks New University, The Open University, Croydon College and Jisc.

<b>Feb</b>	Drafting of code
<b>Mar</b>	Advisory Group to suggest revisions
<b>Apr</b>	Online consultation launched across sector to get wider feedback
<b>Early May</b>	Advisory Group to review suggestions from sector
<b>Late May</b>	Final draft agreed by Advisory Group
<b>June</b>	Code launched by Jisc
