**Priority 3:** Learning analytics support and networks






# **Basic learning analytics solution**

### Updated timetable

May –June 2015	Initial meetings with selected suppliers to initiate contracts and develop products.
June – Sept 2015	Institutions invited to participate in <b>Discovery Stage</b> or <b>Pilots</b>
Year 1	Discovery Stage (10-20 institutions)
Sept 2015 - Aug 2016	Pilots (10+ institutions)
	Institutions move from Discovery to Pilot
Year 2	Discovery Stage (scaled solution)
Sept 2016 - Aug 2017	Institutions move from Discovery to Pilot
	Institutions continue Pilots, potentially adding other
	services



# Priority 1: Basic learning analytics solution





# **Discovery Phase**

Stage 1: Questionnaire to collect readiness information and for institution to express interest. (June/July onwards)

- Discovery –Select preferred approach for the discovery phase. Open to ~20 institutions
- Pilot Select solution preference (Year 1 15 proprietary and 15 open).

Stage 2: Provide a scalable discovery phase with an online tool and support via consultants and/or Jisc. Open to all institutions.

Institutions select preference for solution. Open to all.



# **Code of Practice**

Advisory Group includes representatives from National Union of Students, Edinburgh, Huddersfield, Lancaster and Loughborough Universities, Bucks New University, The Open University, Croydon College and Jisc.
